September 4-6 th	Delta Fair	Absent from School two days Depart MHS at 7:00 a.m. <i>(your sheep need to be fitted prior to this day)</i>
September 7 th	Dyer County	Depart MHS at 8:00 am <i>(Sheep will already be in Dyer Co.)</i>
September 10 th	West TN State Fair	Leaving at 1:30 p.m. <i>(your sheep need to be fitted prior to this day)</i>
September 11-13 th	Tennessee State Fair <i>(Not all students will be going up on the same day. The show is spread out over three days.)</i>	Depart from @ 5:00 a.m.
September 14 th	Lincoln County Fair	Depart MHS @ 5:00 a.m.
Oct. 7-8 th (OPTIONAL – DURING FALL BREAK)	AR State Fair Jr. Show	Depart MHS @ 8:00 a.m. <i>(your sheep need to be fitted prior to this day)</i>

WHAT TO TAKE TO A SHOW:

SHOW CLOTHES: *You will need boots, jeans and a button down shirt (or dress shirt for girls)!*

WORK CLOTHES: *Please pack your Munford Livestock Shirt!*

TOILETRIES: *Deodorant, Hair Brush (Items when you change for the show to look presentable).*

CHANGE OF SOCKS: *Your feet will be wet from washing.*

RAINCOAT: *If it is raining we will still have to unload the trailer and sheep.*

MONEY FOR FOOD AND ENTERTAINMENT: *Fair food or meals traveling*
